Baltimore Oak is a vintage Reclaimed Wood with warm authenticity. Originating from the Balkan region of Europe, the wood comes from buildings that were constructed over 150 years ago. Sourced from old mills, homes and churches, the Baltimore Oak was once structural beams that were integral to these longstanding buildings. The Baltimore Oak is treated with natural stain giving it a beautifully gray coloring. The Oak is sliced thin and applied to an MDF board, opening up new possibilities for designing with Reclaimed Wood.
