

The Guglielmo Family Winery opened its doors in 1925 and is the longest continuously operating winery in Santa Clara Valley. Tucked away along the hills just south of San Jose, the family owned winery is as scenic and popular as it is historic.

For the last 90 years, the Guglielmo Winery used the same Redwood tanks to age, ferment, and store their wine. The tanks held up to 60,000 gallons of their beautifully colored, aromatic wine, while also giving it an unmistakable flavor. As the industry shifted to stainless steel tanks, so did the Guglielmo Winery. As a result, the historic Redwood tanks are available to be repurposed into new projects.
