The Story: Guglielmo Redwood



Well known for its technology, it's easy to forget that Silicon Valley is also home to some of the oldest, premier wineries in California. The Guglielmo Family Winery, which opened its doors in 1925, is now in its third generation and is the longest continuously operating winery in Santa Clara Valley. Tucked away along the hills just south of San Jose, the family owned winery is as scenic and popular as it is historic.

In 1909, when Emilio and Emilia Guglielmo emigrated from Italy, they brought with them the charm and wine making tradition of their homeland. By 1925, the couple had saved enough money to purchase a lush 15-acre lot in the rolling hills of Morgan Hill. From humble beginnings, the Guglielmo Family Winery has grown to produce a variety of award-winning wines from more than 100 acres of vineyard estates throughout California.

For the last 90 years, the Guglielmo winery has used the same Redwood tanks to age, ferment, and store their wine. These tanks held up to 60,000 gallons of their beautifully colored, aromatic wine, while also giving it an unmistakable flavor. As the industry shifted to stainless steel tanks to better control flavor, so did the Guglielmo Winery. As a result, the historic Redwood tanks are available to be repurposed into new projects.

On the inside of the wine staves, the beautiful old-growth Redwood is deeply stained with red wine, giving the wood a full-bodied character and vibrant aroma. The outside of the staves include well-preserved strap marks and a uniform rich brown coloration. The Guglielmo Redwood is evidence of this family's values for hard work, craftsmanship, and authentic tradition.
