The Story: Vintage Oak



Vintage Oak is a reclaimed wood with rugged authenticity. Originating from the Balkan region of Croatia and Romania, the wood comes from buildings that were constructed over 150 years ago. Withstanding the area's whirlwind history, from the Industrial Revolution, two World Wars and the crumbling of the Soviet Union, our Vintage Oak has a patina that reflects triumph over hardship. Now, this region of Eastern Europe, with its rolling hills and compelling past, is a popular tourist destination. Due to newfound popularity, the eastern European countries are renovating and modernizing their historic buildings, which are now in vogue.

Sourced from old mills, homes and churches, Vintage Oak was once structural beams that were integral to these longstanding buildings. Until their deconstruction, the exposed Oak beams stood tall and remained largely intact for hundreds of years. Since this material is unusually old, it has a distinctive brown coloring that only comes from the natural aging process, which takes a very long time, especially for Oak.

This material combines the look and feel of solid Oak and is available in a convenient, panelized product for easier integration and installation as architectural millwork. Vintage Oak material is available in three shades: **Vintage Harlem** (lighter toned), **Vintage Hoboken** (deep brown) and **Vintage Baltimore** (smoke-grey hued). These Vintage Oak panels open new possibilities for designing with recycled real wood.
